State of New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection Application Form:

Applicant: Mark & Deborah Stackpole. Block 1403, Lots: 21, 21.01, 22, 23 & 24. Project Description: To construct a single family dwelling and recreational docks consisting of a 4' x 140' pier with an 8' x 20' "L" pier, two 2' x 20' finger piers and two open 13' x 13' boat lifts. Location of project: 1010 Balsam Drive, Bayville, NJ. No action taken.

State of New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection Division of Water Quality Treatment Works Approval Permit Application received on May 19, 2016. Applicant/Owner: Jessica Montalvo. Location of activity: Block 520, Lots: 1, 2, 5, 7, 9, 11, 13, 15, 17. Name of Facility Site: Roadway Improvement Plan for McKinley Avenue. Project Description: The project proposes to extend 400 lineal feet of 8" PVC gravity sewer main from the existing manhole located in McKinley Avenue. It is proposed to connect 4 dwellings to the system with a future of 4 more dwellings. No action taken.
